## Libraries Support AHEC Summer Camps

Peg Seger, Head of Briscoe Library Outreach Services, taught health literacy and database search skills to high school students enrolled in the AHEC College Academy on June 12th. Students learned about health information literacy and reliable health information sites like *MedlinePlus* made available through the National Library of Medicine (NLM). Students also learned how to search for medical information with databases like *PubMed*. Erika Silva, Library Assistant, provided a library orientation to familiarize students with the resources and services the library has to offer. Students also watched a 12-minute educational video to improve awareness of the skin staph infection CA-MRSA. A pre and post test was given to students to assess their knowledge of the infection before and after viewing the video. This video was also presented to the AHEC Youth Health Service Corps students on July 15th.

On June 18th, Library Assistant Maria Cantu presented to the 6th and 7th graders at the AHEC Junior Academy Science Camp on the importance of a medical library in the community. Students learned what a medical library is, how few there are in Texas and therefore how fortunate Laredo is to have one, and what our Regional Campus Library has to offer.

At the AHEC Summer Biomedical Enrichment Program in July, Peg Seger spoke to students about the Medical Librarian Profession. Students learned about the roles and responsibilities of a medical librarian as well as the education required and resources for teens interested in the career.
