ClinicalKey to Replace MD Consult

MD Consult, a collection of electronic books and journals including the “Clinics in...” series published by Elsevier, will cease publication at the end of 2014. It is being replaced by ClinicalKey, a more comprehensive system that includes 1,100 e-books, 550 e-journals including most of the “Clinics in...” review journals, 13,000 videos, 4,000 practice guidelines, and a large collection of patient handouts. Following positive results of a trial period conducted last year, the library will be subscribing to ClinicalKey. There will be a transition period between canceling MD Consult at the end of April and licensing the content in ClinicalKey. During that time, ClinicalKey will be available on a trial basis [here](#).

In order to mitigate some of the increased cost of ClinicalKey, the library will not purchase print copies of the books and journals in ClinicalKey unless requested by faculty, students or staff. Librarians will closely monitor the use of ClinicalKey in this first subscription year to make sure the cost of the system is justified by its use.

Community Advisors View CA-MRSA Video

On Friday, May 2nd, the UT Health Science Center Libraries met for their bi-annual Community Advisors meeting by videoconference between the Briscoe Library in San Antonio, the Ramirez Library in Harlingen, and the Laredo Regional Campus Library. On the agenda was a viewing of a CA-MRSA Educational video put together by the UTHSC Library in conjunction with Dr. Chris Frei, Dr. Grace Lee, and Paula Winkler of the South Central AHEC. Also contributing to this project are Dr. Carlos Jaen, Professor and Chair of the UTHSCSA Department of Family and Community Medicine and Robert Merrill and his video production team at the UT Health Science Center. In support of this project, the Libraries received an award from the South Central Region of the National Network of Libraries of Medicine.

The video is in its final stages of editing. Once finalized, it will be made available to community-based health care clinics in South Texas and ultimately to wider audiences through the use of social media and submission for inclusion in MedlinePlus[®], the online consumer-oriented health site produced by the National Library of Medicine (NLM).
